# Sport and Recreation Career Development Program



The Sport and Recreation Career Development Program aims to equip participants with a better understanding of the sport and recreation industry, increased leadership skills and improved industry networks.

## Emerging Professionals

Offered to a maximum of ten employees in Western Australia who have worked in the sport and recreation industry for no more than five years, hold a reasonable level of industry knowledge and display the potential to be a future leader.

The program will provide selected participants with the following:

- Attendance at a specialised industry networking event with representatives from sport and recreation organisations.
- Professional development workshops on varying topics.
- Assistance to complete an official accreditation in their area.
- Attendance at an industry conference.
- A mentor for the duration of the program.
- An official certificate of recognition.

The following will be required of participants throughout the program's duration:

- Attendance at all organised events and workshops.
- Undertake an individual volunteer project.
- Complete a short report and presentation.
